3. According to John 6:30-32, 41-43 & 52 what disputes did the Jews have with Jesus? How did Jesus respond? (32-33, 35-40, 42-52) What are common disputes against the claims of Jesus today? How do you respond to those from a biblical basis?
4. Who do you believe Jesus is? Is Christ alone sufficient to satisfy your needs? If so, explain how. Where do you struggle to be satisfied in Christ? Where do you struggle to allow your faith in Christ's work to be the means of your standing with God? Where are you prone to atone for your own sin? Where are you trying to base your relationship with God on your own work and not Christ's?
