4. How do you know you are one of our Lord’s sheep? (Rom. 1:16-7, 3-4, 8:1; 1 John 1:6-10, 2:1-4, 19, 5:1-5; Acts 17:26-17) What significance does Jesus calling His sheep by name have for you?
